<p>How was the life of people in Indus Valley Civilization similar to and different from those of people in your neighborhood today?</p> <p>Write a short story describing one aspect of the life of people in Indus Valley Civilization.</p> <p>Create one artifact of your choice from the Harappan Civilization. Use that artifact to give a 5 minute presentation to the class explaining about the life in Harappan Civilization</p>	<p>What role did time and place play in the development of Indus Valley Civilization?</p> <p>Develop an exhibit of toys, clothes, jewelry, seals and figurines from Harappan civilization for the class museum.</p> <p>Construct a map depicting the different sites where Indus Valley remains were discovered.</p>	<p>How can the methods of inquiry of anthropology, sociology, history, economics, and geography contribute to the understanding of the Indus Valley Civilization?</p> <p>Write a historical account of development of Indus Valley Civilization based on evidence from primary and secondary sources.</p> <p>Present a media documentary about the cultural contribution of Indus Valley Civilization.</p>
